FULL MEMBERS (INCORPORATED)

Full membership is offered to funded incorporated NFP community-controlled LGBTIQ+ health organisations whose sole business is promoting the prevention and control of disease to lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex people (to one or more group) by delivering health and wellbeing services and programs either within a jurisdiction or nationally.

An LGBTIQ+ community-controlled organisation is an incorporated LGBTIQ+ organisation, initiated, based in and governed by members from LGBTIQ+ communities to deliver health and wellbeing services to LGBTIQ+ people and communities. The definition of health and wellbeing services and programs includes such programs that address the social determinants of health.

An LGBTIQ+ community-controlled organisation is an incorporated LGBTIQ+ organisation, initiated, based in and governed by members from LGBTIQ+ communities to deliver health and wellbeing services to LGBTIQ+ people and communities. The definition of health and wellbeing services and programs includes such programs that address the social determinants of health.

- Can demonstrate that the organisation has a Board of Governance >50% LGBTIQ+ representation.
- For unincorporated entities demonstration of oversight and control is by LGBTIQ+ individuals
- Be an Australian incorporated NFP
- Undertake to act lawfully and in a manner consistent with the objects of LGBTIQ+ Health Australia

 - » To promote the health and wellbeing of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex and other sexuality, sex and gender diverse people).
 - » To promote the prevention and control of disease among LGBTIQ+ people.
 - » To reduce disadvantage and discrimination experienced by LGBTI people.
 - » To eliminate disparities in health outcomes of LGBTIQ+ people and communities including differences that occur by sexual and/or gender orientation, identity and/or presentation, gender, race/ethnicity, education or income, disability, nationality, geographic location, and/or age.
 - » To increase availability of, access to, and quality of physical, mental and behavioural health and related services for LGBTIQ+ people.
 - » To develop the capacity of LHA's full members to promote the health and wellbeing of LGBTIQ+ people, including the development of health intelligence, networking opportunities, financial resources and workforce development.
 - » To engage and collaborate with those organisations, institutions or bodies, which in the opinion of the Company support and uphold the Company's Objects, to encourage initiatives, and assist in development of innovative programs aimed at promoting community awareness of LGBTIQ+ health issues.
 - » To influence public and private sector policy and programs regarding LGBTIQ+ health and related issues.
